

**2023 A New Tool for Measuring Curtin's Unit and Teaching Satisfaction  
Pilot Study Prize draw – Sem 1 Event**

**Student Competition Terms and Conditions**

1. Instructions on how to enter and other details contained within promotional advertisements for this competition form part of the conditions of entry.
  2. By entering the competition, entrants agree to abide by these Terms and Conditions.
  3. The Terms and Conditions of this competition are governed by the laws of the State of Western Australia.
  4. The competition is being run by Curtin University of Technology, GPO Box U1987, Perth, Western Australia, 6845 ("Curtin").
  5. The 2023 Pilot Study Sem 1 Event Student Competition ("the competition") will commence at 0:00 Australian Western Standard Time (AWST) on **30 May 2023**.
  6. The competition will close at 23:59 AWST on **25 June 2023**.
  7. The competition is open to students from participating campuses who are enrolled in units running in the study periods included in the pilot (which runs between **30 May 2023 and 25 June 2023**) and who receive an email invitation from [CurtinSurveys@curtin.edu.au](mailto:CurtinSurveys@curtin.edu.au) to participate.
  8. To enter the competition, students must complete the pilot survey and separate feedback form in full and provide valid contact details between **30 May 2023 and 25 June 2023**.
  9. Entry to the competition is free. Students will be responsible for all costs associated with entering the competition, which may include costs associated with accessing the internet.
  10. By entering the competition, the students agree that they are over the age of 18 years, or if under the age of 18 years, have their parent's or legal guardian's consent to enter the competition.
  11. The prize winner, or if under the age of 18 years their parent or legal guardian, may be required to provide evidence of their identity (such as photographic ID, birth certificate or current passport) when receiving the prize.
  12. The prizes comprise of:
    - Four (4) x AUD \$100 Prezzy Australian eGift cards of their choice (from <https://www.prezzy.com.au>; some exclusions may apply).
    - Curtin reserves the right to offer equivalent prizes of the same value.
- The total prize pool is valued at **AUD\$400**.
13. The draws will take place **within 2 weeks of the closing date** and take place at Building 100, Level 4, Office of Strategy and Planning, Curtin University, Kent Street, Bentley. The draws will be by a random number generation using the Random Integer Generator provided by RANDOM.ORG with each entry assigned a unique and sequential identifying number. Using only the RANDOM.ORG Random Integer Generator, identifying numbers will be returned as winners.
  14. The prize winners will be contacted within seven (7) days of the draw by the email addresses or telephone contacts provided by the entrant.
  15. If the prize winner does not respond to claim the prize within twenty-one (21) days of the draw, a re-draw will be conducted within thirty (30) days of the original draw date, in the same location, and with the same method.
  16. Curtin's decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
  17. Curtin is not responsible in any manner whatsoever for any problems or any financial costs incurred, or any combination thereof, including any injury or damage to participants or any other persons related to or resulting from participation in this competition.
