

2023 Curtin International Student Barometer (ISB) Survey (March-June 2023)

Competition Terms and Conditions

- 1. Instructions on how to enter and other details contained within promotional advertisements for this competition form part of the conditions of entry.
- 2. By entering the competition, entrants agree to abide by these Terms and Conditions.
- 3. The Terms and Conditions of this competition are governed by the laws of the State of Western Australia.
- 4. The competition is being run by The Office of Strategy and Planning, Curtin University of Technology, GPO Box U1987, Perth, Western Australia, 6845 ("Curtin").
- 5. The 2023 Curtin ISB Survey Competition ("the competition") will commence at 0:00 Australian Western Standard Time (AWST) on 20 March 2023.
- 6. The competition will close at 23:59 AWST on 5 June 2023.
- 7. The competition is open to selected international students from Curtin's Australian campuses who receive an invitation from CurtinSurveys@curtin.edu.au
- 8. To enter the competition, students must complete and submit a survey in full and provide valid contact details and opt in to be included in the draw, before the closing time.
- 9. Entry to the competition is free. Students will be responsible for all costs associated with entering the competition, which may include costs associated with accessing the internet.
- 10. Students will automatically enter the competition with the successful submission of their survey and
 - a) opting to be included and
 - b) providing valid contact details
- 11. By entering the competition, the students agree that they are over the age of 18 years, or if under the age of 18 years, have their parent's or legal guardian's consent to enter the competition.
- 12. The prize winner, or if under the age of 18 years their parent or legal guardian, may be required to provide evidence of their identity (such as photographic ID, birth certificate or current passport) when receiving the prize.
- 13. The prizes comprise an Australian eGift card of the winner's choice from the Prezzee website at https://www.prezzee.com.au/ to the value of:
 - a) First prize AU\$200 gift voucher
 - b) Second prize AU\$200 gift voucher
 - c) Third prize AU\$200 gift voucher
 - The total prize pool for the competition is AU\$600.
- 14. The draw will be undertaken by i-graduate (the research company commissioned by Curtin to undertake the survey) a few weeks after the survey closes. The winner/s and their details will be sent to The Office of Strategy and Planning to administer the prize/s.
- 15. The prize winner/s will be contacted within seven (7) days of the draw by the email addresses or telephone contacts provided in their survey submission and/or available in the Student One student database system.



- 16. If the prize winner does not respond to claim the prize within twenty-one (21) days of the draw, a re-draw will be conducted within thirty (30) days of the original draw date, in the same location, and with the same method.
- 17. The prize winners' names may be published on the Curtin website. By entering the competition, entrants grant Curtin permission to use their full name and course of study on its website and /or in future survey invitations.
- 18. Curtin's decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
